



Two seniors soar to Eagle Scout status

Corey Austin Barnett (right) and Nicholas Tomko of Boy Scout Troop 186 recently attained the rank of Eagle Scout. Barnett, 17, is a senior at Lebanon High School and is the son of Les and Dana Barnett of Lebanon. For his Eagle Scout project, Barnett and fellow troop members worked 261 hours to create a "spiritual labyrinth" at Resurrection Lutheran Church in Lebanon. A ceremony was held at the church Oct. 28. Tomko, 18, also is a senior at Lebanon High School and is the son of Dan and Laura Tomko of Lebanon. For his Eagle Scout project, Tomko raised money to erect two aluminum bleachers for the athletic department at St. Francis de Sales Church in Lebanon. With help from troop members, Tomko generated \$1,300 through various fundraisers for the project. A ceremony was held Dec. 3 at Lebanon Presbyterian Church. The rank of Eagle is achieved by only 4 percent of all boys who enter the Scouts. Barnett and Tomko were the 20th and 21st boys from Troop 186 who have achieved the rank since 1994. Contributed photo
