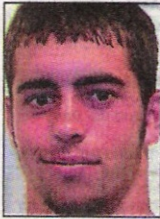


# Area players reap awards

Three Middletown area basketball players were recognized at the state level Tuesday.

Monroe junior Tyler Osterman, Madison junior Nathanael Harney and Carlisle junior Braxton Campbell were honored with their selection to the Division III All-Ohio high school boys basketball team, a list which was released Tuesday by the Associated Press.

The list of players was recommended by a statewide media panel.

Harney, who averaged 18.6 points and 10.8 rebounds per game, was named a special mention player on this year's Division III All-Ohio list. The 6-foot-2 forward led Madison (15-6) to a share of the SWBL Buckeye crown.

Harney has received other honors as well this season, including being named to the SWBL Buckeye first team, the Division III Southwest District first team and the Division III District 15 Underclassmen first team.

Campbell, a 6-foot-1 guard who averaged 17.5 points per game, led the Indians (17-6) to the Division III sectional finals before their season ended.
